



The SWD Senior Chorus will perform at the Midwinter Convention in San Antonio this January!

The Society told us that it would select the top five scoring choruses from all the districts to perform at Midwinter, but apparently, only five choruses competed. Therefore, all will sing at the Midwinter convention. The five choruses are as follows:

Evergreen District: Evergreen Senior Chorus
Carolinas District: Carolina Statesmen
Ontario District: The Maple Leaf Chord Company
Johnny Appleseed District: Vocal Seniority
The Southwestern District: Southwestern Vintage Voices

Currently, we have around 87 singers registered with our Senior chorus, but I have been informed that if we want to add more between now and January, we can do it! So, if you are someone who might be interested in singing with the Senior Chorus, and you are 55 years of age or older, just go to the District website at swd.org and click on the Senior Chorus link. If you registered to sing with us at this past District convention, you're already in.

Our director, Artie Dolt, would like to see us have 120 singers on stage at Midwinter, so, if you're interested, sign up! We are singing two songs, "From the first hello to the last goodbye," and "I love to hear that old barbershop style." If you sign up, I'll send you sheet music and learning tracks. As for our attire for the performance at Midwinter, it will be the same as at District..black pants, shoes and sox, white shirt, solid long tie of any color.

One other requirement for all: You must be registered for the Midwinter Convention to be able to sing in the Senior Chorus. I just recently heard about that requirement.
